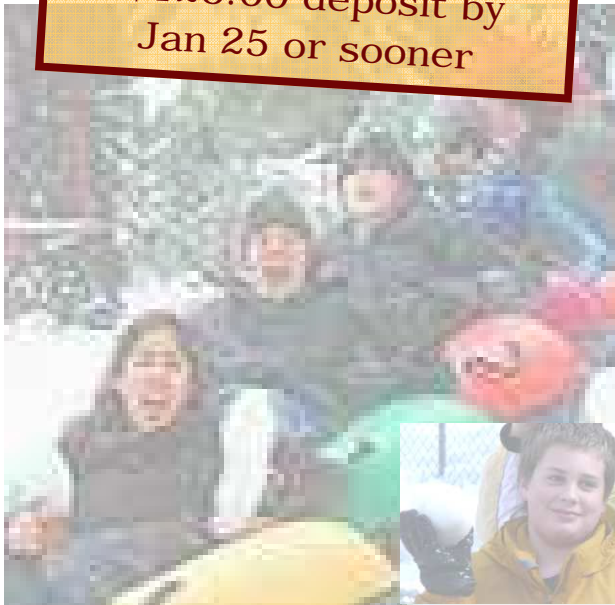

Schedule

Friday, Feb. 10

8:00am — Meet at VSPC.

Check in: pay balance due; by Jan 27 complete Hume's medical release form online; campers will have a health screening check just before getting on the bus. Depart VSPC by 8:45am.

- * Load your small labeled duffel bag & sleeping bag in baggage vehicle. Keep a backpack with you on the bus for your jacket, snacks, water bottle and \$25-50 spending money plus \$6.00 for lunch stop.
- * It is a 5 hour drive up to the camp!!

* **1:00pm — Leave Hume Lake**
We will arrive home to VSPC around 6:00pm.
